CATSINaM and RDN have partnered to deliver these bursary funds to NSW under-grad student members who are in need of financial relief as a result of current study & work restrictions.

### Terms and Conditions

- Funding is available to under-grad CATSINaM student members studying nursing or midwifery in NSW
- Bursaries are paid as a reimbursement to the individual and will not be paid on a cash basis
- The maximum bursary amount per successful applicant will be \$250
- The bursaries are for reimbursement of funds spent on the following:
  - Internet data
  - Study materials
  - Making home study environment safer
