Cultural Safety – 1 day Workshop

Cultural safety is of critical importance for supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People are dealing with racism and they are significantly under-represented in the workforce in Australia.

Cultural Safety training is vital to address racism and support Indigenous Australians. One way to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People is to ensure we have a shared understanding of Cultural Safety and what it means, this includes the knowledge and skills to address racism and to recognise racism in the workplace.

Overview: This one-day workshop provides an opportunity for non-Indigenous people to begin their learning journey and gain an understanding of what it's like to be an Indigenous Australian.

Learning outcomes: There are three intended outcomes:

1. To develop the participants understanding of Cultural Safety.
2. To strengthen knowledge and skills in understanding and addressing racism.
3. To identify ways to support Indigenous Australians.

Participant numbers: Minimum of 20 people and maximum of 25 people.
