The Badanami Tertiary Entry Preparation program aims to prepare Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students for participation in university level study. The program includes a series of self-paced, distance-mode modules that introduce university study and research skills and develop academic literacy skills. Bandanami Alternative Entry program enables Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who do not have an HSC, other qualification, or have a ATAR score lower than required an alternative means to apply for university. UWS College University foundation studies, associate degree programs, professional and community programs, diploma programs Scholarships	TAFE/VET graduates are offered entry into some courses and in most cases credit towards their UWS degree.
