It's a one-day testing and assessment program held on-campus, candidates complete a 'personal statement' outlining their suitability and plans for studying at UNE and a number of academic literacy tests.</p> <p>Pathways Enabling Course prepares prospective students for admission to an undergraduate course at UNE. Free from course fees and available online. Provides minimum entry requirements and can provide credit towards an UNE degree.</p> <p>TRACKS is a tertiary preparation course for Aboriginal and Torres Strait islander students who would like to develop the skills and knowledge to study at UNE. This program is over two trimesters to experience what university study is about and learn in a supported environment.
